What

EOSC is the European web of FAIR data and related services for research

Research data that is easy to find, access, interoperate and reuse (FAIR)

Trusted and sustainable research outputs are available within and across scientific disciplines

Why

Unlock the full potential of research data to accelerate discoveries and innovation


How

- Enabling the definition of standards, and the development of tools and services, to allow researchers to find, access, reuse and combine results
- Establishing a sustainable and federated infrastructure enabling open sharing of scientific results
- Ensuring that Open Science practices and skills are rewarded and taught, becoming the 'new normal'

As described in the Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA)

Where do we stand?

- After an initial period of many projects without much convergence (2015-2020) a co-programmed partnership was signed by the EOSC-A and the EC to foster the converge in the implementation period (2021-2026).
- For this it is essential that we get a Minimal Viable EOSC (MVE / EOSC-EUnode) operational aligned with work done by all the relevant communities (European, National and Institutional).
- Extension to the Wider Public sector foreseen in 2025-27








The EOSC EU Node Landing page and Resource Hub






The EOSC EU Node Resources



meosc Distribution of submissions



- Questionnaire for parties interested in contributing to the build-up phase of the EOSC Federation closes, attracting 121 responses
- Questionnaire period:
 12 June to 31 Aug 2024

- Tripartite Group presents assessment of responses to the questionnaire at the European Tripartite Event in Budapest
- Assessment period:
 1 Sep to 7 Nov 2024

- Build-up phase of the EOSC Federation culminates
- Period: Q1-Q3 2025
